Day 1: Antananarivo (30mn - Transfer)

You will be met on arrival at the airport and transferred to your city hotel.

Overnight at le Pavillon de l'Emyrne (or similar)

Day 2: Antananarivo - Morondava

Transfer to the airport for your flight to Morondava. Upon arrival, you'll be transferred to your hotel.

After check in, there's a meeting with the members of the tours team at lunch. Afternoon you will take the quad for your first tour to a romantic sunset at the Baobab Avenue.

Lunch, dinner and overnight at Palissandre hotel or similar

Day 3: Morondava – Belo sur Mer (109 km.) (1st day raid)

After breakfast there will be a briefing before the departure at 09h00.

Very attractive track until Belo-sur-Mer, you will see a landscape of 'bush' of the scrawny vegetations which resist to the prolonged droughts. You will cross the first ford of Kabatomena, approximately 150m of wide.

You arrive to Belo by the sea in the mid afternoon.

Belo sur Mer is famous for its turquoise blue lagoon. Beautiful white sandy beach with very soft water temperature. Belo-sur-Mer is also an important place of "Boutre" (traditional boat) construction. Enjoy a party of sailing board, or diving.

Diner and overnight at Ecolodge du Menabe.

Lunch in excursion

Day 4: Belo-sur-Mer – Manja (109 km). (2nd day raid)

After breakfast there will be a briefing before the departure at 09h00.

Full day crossing the salt works tracks. The vegetation is marked by the presence of jujubiers and raised savanna, then by Sakalava graves famous by their sacred wooden Totems (Aloalo). You'll arrive to Manja late afternoon.

'**Manja**' was XIV. the former capital of the ancient Sakalava kingdom .Today the village serves just asr stopover for the tracks linking the region to Tulear.

Dinner and overnight in bivouac.

Lunch during excursion





Day 5: Manja – Bevoay (82 km) (3rd day raid)

After breakfast there will be a briefing before the departure at 09h00. You'll spend one day in the Malagasy savanna. You'll cross particularly technical tracks.

After a memorable adventure, you arrive towards end afternoon on the bank of Bevoay for the bivouac.

The village of '**Bevoay**' has no particular attraction but a bivouac on the bank of the Mangoky River will give particularly an exotic aspect and a local colour to your trip.

Dinner and overnight in bivouac.

Lunch during excursion

Day 6: Bevoay – Andavadoaka (127 km) (4th day raid)

After breakfast there will be a briefing before the departure at 09h00.

Today you'll experience a long day track to join Andavadoaka. Very wild party between Bevoay and Morombe through a landscape of savanna. The Track is lined with Baobabs then you will cross the plain of Mangoky before arriving at Morombe for the lunch.

From Morombe to Andavadoaka, easy track lined with baobabs, a magnificent place with its creek at the edge of the Mozambique Channel protected by the coral reef.

'**Andavadoaka**' is situated on a beautiful lagoon, and is an ideal retreat for those who look for peaceful places. You can find multiple islets in the surrounds, but they are most of the time forbidden to visit; but you must ask a villager who will be happy to make you experience a few hours Robinson to one of them by pirogue.

Dinner and overnight at Laguna Blue Resorts

Lunch in excursion

Day 7: Andavadoaka – Salary (64 km) (5th day raid)

After breakfast there will be a briefing before the departure at 08h00.

Today you'll follow the sandy tracks on the west coast of Madagascar. Great feeling of immensity in the middle of dunes of sands, you will cross along large white sandy beaches till Salary.

'**Salary**' is a small village on one the most beautiful bay of Madagascar: thin sandy beach, coral strands with enchanting colors, primary forests with still preserved species. An ideal décor with magnificent pure blue sea ...a perfect and guaranteed retreat

Dinner and overnight at hotel Salary Bay

Lunch in excursion





Day 8: Salary

Day at leisure. Optional activities are available at the hotel.

Dinner and overnight at the hotel at Salary Bay.

Day 9: Salary – Ifaty (84 km) (6th and last day raid)

After breakfast there will be a briefing before the departure at 09h00.

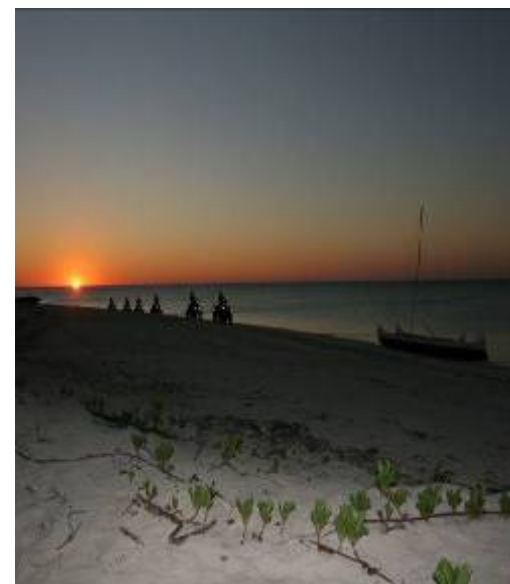
The track is rather easier till Ifaty. You'll note the scrawny and thorny vegetation which lines the road; dry forests with Didiéracées, and Euphorbiaceae. You'll arrive late afternoon in Ifaty

'Ifaty' is very famous for the large wide of nautical activities it can offer; protected by a large coral reef, it is the paradise for diver and have magnificent underwater sites .A perfect blend of turquoise lagoon and sub – desert vegetation of the inland; it is also very rich in medicinal plants .

After an early breakfast transfer to Tulear for your flight to Antananarivo or for an extension (on request)
